Course Aims

To provide thorough theory and practical training in operating the 180 Excavator, to enable the candidate to pass the theory and practical assessments.

Recommended Duration: (Max 4 candidates per course)

Novice: 2 - 5 Days

Intermediate: 2 Days

Experienced: 1 Day Refresher Assessment

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Carry out pre-start checks.
- Identify the basic construction components, and the purpose and use of all controls and gauges.
- Prepare the excavator for site and road travel.
- Travel over varying terrain, including rough undulating ground.
- Travel up and down substantial inclines.
- Manoeuvre the excavator in confined areas.
- Prepare the machine to excavate.
- Excavate below ground level on a variety of excavations in different ground types.
- Place spoil into various sizes of vehicles.
- Grade, spread and level different types of material.
- Remove and re-attach buckets.
- Place the excavator in the safe park position.
- Explain the loading and unloading procedures on and off a transporter.

Once you have passed and completed the course you will receive a certificate in training for 180 Excavator, along with a Lantra card.
