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Lantra Wheeled Loading Shovel

Course Aims

To provide thorough theory and practical training in operating the Loading Shovel, to enable the candidate to pass the theory and practical assessments.

Recommended Duration:

(Max 4 candidates per course)

Novice: 2 - 4 Days

Intermediate: 2 Days

Experienced: 1 Day Refresher Assessment

On completion of the course you will be able to:

- Carry out pre-start checks.
- Identify the basic construction components, and the purpose and use of all controls and gauges.
- Prepare the loading shovel for travel.
- Travel over varying terrain, including rough undulating ground with and without a load.
- Travel up and down substantial inclines with and without a load.
- Manoeuvre in confined areas, with and without a load.
- Prepare the machine to excavate.
- Carry out excavations from an embankment of different materials and form stockpiles and ramps.
- Clean, spread and level different types of terrain.
- Load various types of materials into receptacles, such as vehicles, hoppers and so on.
- Place the loading shovel in the safe park position.
- Explain the loading and unloading procedures on and off a transporter.

Once you have passed and completed the course you will receive a certificate in training for Wheeled Loading Shovel, along with a Lantra card.

Please remember to bring a passport sized photo with you on the day if you are applying for a card for the first time, or if you require an updated photo on your old card.
